For nearly 70 years, *Christianity Today* has been a storyteller of the global Church, advancing the stories and ideas of the kingdom of God.

From its founding by Billy Graham in 1956, CT set out to become, in Graham's words, a "flag to follow," an institution that would both inspire and challenge the Church in pursuit of a simple goal: for all people to love Christ and his kingdom.

We steward a remarkable legacy, but we are even more excited about our future. Today, CT is a global nonprofit media ministry that reaches 35 million people a year, with the goal of making the Bride of Christ more beautiful and the world more drawn to her.




Our time is critical, but we serve a God who has defeated our greatest enemy. We serve a God who can do all things.
